English manuscripts should be typed in "Times New Roman" font 12 pitch font-size and single space. Hindi manuscripts should be typed in "KrutiDev-10" font 14 pitch font-size and single space. Manuscript must have Title, author's name and institution's name in bold.

Participants are kindly requested to submit separate papers for presentation and publication. Papers presented live during the seminar will not be considered for publication.
