Seminar Report

A two days National Seminar on the topic “70Years of India’s Independence, Gains Accumulated and Losses Incurred, Path Ahead: An Overview” was organized by Govt. Raza P G College, Rampur (UP) on 29 – 30 Nov. 2016. **Inaugural session** was started at 10 AM on 29th Nov. 2016, with the ceremonial reception of Guests and dignitaries. After the lightening of Deepak and welcome song by students, The **Convener of Seminar, Dr. Saeeda Begum** Welcome the Chief Guest, Guest of honor, learned delegates and other invitees, who had assembled to grace the occasion. The **Organizing Secretary, Dr. Baby Tabassum** introduced the theme and various subthemes of seminar to the audience.

Actual agenda of the seminar started with the meaningful deliberation of honorable chief guest, **Prof. Mohammad Yunus, Vice-chancellor, Mohammad Ali Jauhar University, Rampur**. Being a scientist, he focused on achievements in the field of science and technology, also the scientific and innovative skills of Indian common man. He also told that we should hold the responsibilities along with enjoying achievements. Further, the Guest of honour, **Dr. R. P. Yadav, Regional Higher Education Officer, Bareilly** carried his deliberation with more advance scientific approach, the Nano-technology and its future perspectives in India. He is a physicist, so discussed the scientific innovations in India. He also presented a model curriculum for graduate and postgraduate students with scientific and computer approaches. He said that it is the high time to renovate our model education and research system.

The first Technical session of seminar started with Speech of **Dr. Dinesh Chahal Asst. Prof., Department of Education, Central University of Haryana, Mahendergarh (Haryana)**.

He is renowned National level socialist and educationist. He communicated mainly with youths, the students. He inspired them for social services, motivated their nationalism. He also told them the strength of unity, to be a true citizen and not to be disturbed by political dirt like communalism and racism. His passionate speech filled the seminar hall with enthusiasm, excitement and joy. The session was further proceeded by touching literary speech of **Dr. Anil Rai, Associate Prof., Department of Hindi, Shyam Lal College, Shahdara, Delhi**. He presented the independence in the view of Hindi Literature. The seminar hall was in pin drop silence to hear him. He presented the condition of India before and after independence with examples of prose and poetry. He also inspired the feeling of patriotism among the students. Further, **Dr. Kshama Dwivedi, Department of Zoology, Bareilly College, Bareilly** presented her views on “Arsenic and Diabetes” and told about the various ingredients in herbal medicines and their medical importance. The session was proceeded further by lecture of **Dr. Neeraja Asthana, Department of Military Studies, Bareilly College, Bareilly**. She talked over the topic “Peace and Harmony - The Pillars of Human Well Being” and insisted with “If human race wishes to have prolonged and indefinite period of material prosperity, they have only got to believe in a peaceful and helping way towards one another.” At last **Dr. Sangeeta Singh, Department of Zoology, Bareilly College, Bareilly** ended the invited lectures with the interesting topic “Rapid eye Movement sleep: past and future” and revealed various patterns and behaviour during sleep as well as their biological importance.

In the same session, some students and research scholars also presented their papers. At the end of first day, after coffee break, the Invitees were presented with mementos and the presenter students of the day were also encouraged by trophies.

Second day's proceeding (30 Nov. 2016) started with ceremonial reception of Chief Guest **Mr. Azahar Inayati**, a well known educationalist, social activist and shayar of Rampur, **Dr. Zishan Haider**, Asst. Prof., Department of Persian, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Lucknow and other invitees and delegates. The Chief Guest **Mr. Azahar Inayati**,
